What is Seawake?

Seawake is a powerboat membership club


You pay an annual membership fee and in return you have unlimited use of Seawake's fleet of boats at any Seawake location. We make using a powerboat fun! Members have all the fun, Seawake does all the graft - we launch the boat for you, recover it, clean it, refuel it, take care of all maintenance and insurance. Plus Seawake is now on your doorstep with a new location at The Warren.

What are the advantages?

Buying, owning and running a powerboat can be an expensive business, Seawake makes power boating affordable. You get all the fun of using the craft without any of the hassle. No maintenance, no mooring fees, no insurance, no depreciation. In fact all you get is the enjoyment.

**Bookings can be made 30 days in advance by email, telephone or through the website and each member can also book 10 days up to 6 months in advance.*

How does it work?

Seawake is a power boating club. You pay an annual membership fee and in return you have unlimited use of Seawake's fleet of boats. You decide when you want to use a boat by checking the availability on the Seawake Members website.

For example

You book the boat for say 10am on a Sunday*.

1. You turn up at 10am on the agreed Sunday
2. The boat is ready, on the water, all fuelled up and ready to go
3. Just before you leave for the day you give us a rough return time
(you can always phone to change this during the day)
4. At the end of your day we meet you at the appointed time
5. You step off the boat and walk away

It's that simple.

At the end of the day

We clean, refuel and check the boat over ready for the next member to use. You only pay for the fuel that you have used that day.

You don't have to worry about storage, maintenance, insurance, servicing or any of the other costly and time consuming expenses associated with boats — it's all included within the membership fee and we do it all. Easy.

Membership v Ownership

Membership

Seawake offers two membership options:

Annual Membership

Unlimited use of the boats year round.

The annual membership fee is £2,940 per year - £245 per month.

There is NO joining fee but members need to hold the RYA Power Boat Level 2 Qualification*.

Seasonal Membership

April to September - 6 months summer use of the boats.

The seasonal membership fee is £2,070 - £345 per month.

There is NO joining fee but members need to hold the RYA Power Boat Level 2 Qualification.

Both membership fee's includes unlimited use of Seawake's fleet of boats in any Seawake location, life jackets and a selection of water skis, wake boards or towable 'toys', all insurance, servicing, maintenance and storage. In fact everything except for the actual fuel you use.

As the club grows we will add more locations throughout the UK. You will be able to use your membership at any location for any boat. Locations will be shown on the website and members will be informed of any new locations by email.

Ownership

Frequently asked questions

Am I restricted in the number of days I can book?

No - all members have the same access to the boats; a member can book any number of days 30 days in advance or 10 days 6 months in advance. Consecutive day bookings are available Sunday to Friday.

Can I use boats in other Seawake locations?

Yes of course - you are not restricted to any one location.

What happens if the weather is bad?

Safety is paramount, if we feel that the weather is against us we will not launch a boat - however if the weather has turned at Abersoch it may well be fine at Caernarfon - subject to a boat being available we can have one ready and waiting for you.

Who can I take on the boat?

When you use the boat it is your boat, you decide who comes on the boat not us.

Do you have any toys?

We have wakeboards, water skis and donuts and also buoyancy aids.

How does the fuel work?

The boat goes out full of fuel, when you come back we top it back up and you just pay for the fuel you have used.

How many members per boat?

We operate a ratio of 7 members per boat

Terms and Conditions

Cost of Membership

1. The annual cost of membership to Seawake is £2,940.00 (two thousand nine hundred and forty pounds) payable in monthly instalments - deposit of £490 followed by 10 monthly payments of £245. The minimum membership term is 12 months.

2. Seasonal Membership is available from 1st April to 30th September at a rate of £2,070 (two thousand and seventy pounds) payable in 3 monthly instalments of £690. Seasonal Membership is valid for 6 months, renewal for the following season is possible with a deposit of £150 payable in the September prior to the season. This is then deducted from the first membership payment.

Who can be a Member

1. Membership is open to anyone over 18 who holds an RYA Powerboat Level 2 certificate.

2. Joint membership is possible - perfect for friends and families who boat together or would like to share the membership. Shared members can only book 1 boat on any 1 day. While the membership fee remains the same there is a charge of £50 per shared member which covers the insurance administration.

Using the Boats

1. As long as the member is present there is no limit on the number of friends, guests, family members, pets you can have on board — the only limit is the number of persons that the boat is certified to carry.

2. All boats carry safety equipment inc. VHF radio, flares, life jackets, fire extinguishers.

3. All members will be given an initial familiarisation session. There is no charge for this session.

4. While under the members control, the boats become the members responsibility. In the unlikely event of the boat sustaining accidental damage then the member will be informed and charged either the excess on the insurance policy or for the damage if the repair is less than the excess of the insurance policy.

5. We recommend that life jackets are worn at all times by all persons in the boat. Life jackets must be worn by any person being towed on water skis, wakeboard, inflatable toys etc by the boat.

6. Boats are used entirely at the members own risk, Seawake can not be held responsible for the actions of a member while the boat is under the members use and or control.

7. We can only refuse the use of a boat subject to weather conditions and/or if the responsible member appears to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs. Safety is paramount.

Booking The Boats

1. The boats are available from sun rise and must be returned 1 hour prior to sun set every

day apart from the period between 10 January and 20 December.

2. To book either email or telephone the Seawake Office on 01248 716335 or book online.

3. Bookings can be made up to 30 days in advance and each member can request up to 10 boat days to be booked 6 months in advance.

4. Consecutive daily bookings are allowed mid-week Monday to Friday, Friday and Saturday or Sunday and Monday. To book a boat on consecutive days, members book one day online then email boats@seawake.co.uk with the request to book the consecutive day. We will then email all the members, if there are no objections we will book the consecutive day.

Terminating Membership

1. Annual Membership runs for a period of 1 year and will be renewed automatically. Should the member wish to terminate his/her membership then they will need to put this in writing to Seawake 30 days prior to the renewal date of their membership.

2. Seasonal membership terminates after the initial 6 month period. Membership for the following season can be guaranteed by paying a deposit of £150. The deposit is then deducted from the first membership payment.
